With his wide range of successful experiences in the education field, he will address us on **'Cross-sector / Interdisciplinary Leadership in Youth and Education'**.
- **Prof. Christopher Day**, Professor of Education in the School of Education, University of Nottingham; Chair Professor in Beijing Normal University; and Professor of Educational Leadership and Management in the University of Sydney. He has led research and development projects in the areas of teachers' work and lives, and school leadership and change, and he will deliver a keynote speech on **'Building and Sustaining Successful Schools: Why formulas don't work'**.

The Annual General Meeting will precede the 10th Anniversary Conference. We have 8 Councillor vacancies for the new 2-year term of office (2022-2024). Biographies of Keynote Speakers




Dr Gabriel Leung, one of Asia's most respected higher education, health and philanthropic leaders, he is known for his commitment to improving human capabilities, nurturing impactful innovation and building strong institutions. He is Executive Director (Charities and Community) of the Hong Kong Jockey Club overseeing its Charities Trust, while serving as a Governor of The Wellcome Trust – both of which are ranked amongst the top ten philanthropies globally.

Gabriel's career has straddled academe, public service and philanthropy. From 2013 to 2022, he was the longest-serving Dean of Medicine and inaugural Helen and Francis Zimmern Professor in Population Health at the University of Hong Kong. Formerly, he was Hong Kong's first Under Secretary for Food and Health and fifth Director of the Chief Executive's Office in government.

A specialist in public health medicine by training, Gabriel is a leading epidemiologist and global health exponent. His work has revolved around topics that have major population health impact locally, where Hong Kong is a reliable and unique epidemiologic sentinel for mainland China and the Chinese diaspora, or where it is best placed to address the fundamental science at hand globally.

Gabriel's research defined the epidemiology of three novel viral epidemics, namely SARS in 2003, H7N9 influenza in 2013 and most recently COVID-19. As minister, he led Hong Kong government's response against the 2009 influenza pandemic. He was founding co-director of HKU's World Health Organization (WHO) Collaborating Centre for Infectious Disease Epidemiology and Control and founded the Laboratory of Data Discovery for Health (D24H) at the Hong Kong Science and Technology Park. Around the world, Gabriel regularly advises national and international agencies including the World Health Organisation, World Bank, Asian Development Bank, Boao Forum for Asia, Institut Pasteur, Japan Center for International Exchange, National Centre for Infectious Diseases of Singapore and China Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. He is an Adjunct Professor of Peking Union Medical College Hospital and Adjunct Professorial Researcher of the China National Health Development Research Center.



Professor Christopher Day is Professor of Education and member of the Centre for Research on Educational Leadership and Management (CRELM). He is also Professor of Educational Leadership, University of Sydney, Australia; Chair Professor of Educational Leadership, Beijing Normal University, China.

During the last twenty years, he continues to lead national, European and international research and development projects in the areas of teachers' work

and lives and school leadership, and to collaborate in these with colleagues in globally, including invited keynote addresses at several national and international conferences. His abiding interests remain in teacher quality, successful school leadership, improvement and change; and, within these, understanding how schools, school networks and universities may provide effective management and support for teachers' and principals' long-term professional development, wellbeing and effectiveness through research and teaching.

Prof. Day is the founding Editor-in-Chief of 'Teachers and Teaching: Theory and Practice' (TTTP); and a member of the Editorial Boards of The British Educational Research Journal (BERJ), Teaching and Teacher Education (TATE), and the Journal of Educational Administration (JEA).

His national research projects include research on variations in teachers' work, lives and effectiveness; the evaluation of school based continuing professional development; the impact of the leadership of improving and effective schools on pupil outcomes; leading schools in challenging urban contexts; effective classroom teaching; and teacher and school resilience. International projects include a 9 country European project on the work of principals of successful schools in challenging urban contexts; a two-country project on policy enactment; and an International Baccalaureate schools' project on the leadership of the primary years programme. He is currently directing a 20-country international research network on successful school principalship (ISSPP).
